












Find evidence or signs of life found in the intertidal zone.

<p>A crab moult</p> 	<p>Eggs of some kind</p> 	<p>A sign that an animal has been eaten</p> 
<p>An animal that lives in one shell</p> 	<p>An animal that lives in two shells</p> 	<p>An animal living on another animal</p> 
<p>Seaweed living on an animal</p> 	<p>A fish in a tidepool</p> 	<p>Something camouflaged</p> 
<p>Something constructed by humans</p> 	<p>A piece (or many pieces) of litter or marine plastic debris (bring to your teacher)</p> 	<p>A pattern in the sky</p>
