

How to make Pinwheel

1. Print or copy the pinwheel pattern onto 11 x 8.5 paper.
2. Cut along the outside lines only and decorate both sides of the pinwheel pattern.
3. Cut along the dotted lines from each corner towards the center.
4. Use a sharpened pencil to carefully poke a tiny hole through each of the five circles at the corners and center of the pattern.
5. Bend (do not fold!) the corners with the holes so they meet at the center hole.
6. Put the pin through the corner holes and then the center hole, add one or two small beads, and push the pin loosely into the eraser on the pencil.
7. Fold a piece of tape over the sharp end of the pin.
8. Test out your pinwheel in the wind!
