1 Objectives

- What is the main environmental issue or theme of the project(s)?
- Project Goal: Describe exactly what the project will achieve.
- Identify how student learning will be enhanced (e.g., identify curriculum links and skill development).
- Beyond the students, who and/or what will benefit from this project (the environment, community, economy, other)? How?

2 Strategy

- Identify the specific steps that will lead to the completion of the project.
- Determine a timeline for each step or action. Make sure you provide enough time to plan, implement and revise each step as needed.

3 Resources

- What resources are currently available (people, things, funds, etc.)?
- What other resources do you need? How can you potentially access these resources?
 (Note: this is one spot where the WildBC facilitator can help brainstorm and locate resources)
- Is funding required? Outline a budget and brainstorm some ideas as how to obtain funds.

4 Communicating and Celebrating!

- Getting the word out: How will you create awareness of the issue and the project?
- Describe how you will measure the success of the project?
- Celebrating progress or completion of your project is vital. How might you do this?
